Update on April 2007 Election Results: Mr. Lloyd Reeves has been elected as Mayor to serve the City of St. Paul for a term of 4 years. Alderman John Schulte, of Ward 1 and Alderman Nick Sigmund, of Ward 3 have been re-elected. Alderwoman Anna White of Ward 2 has been newly elected. These elected Aldermen will serve for a term of 2 years. The city would like to extend its thanks to Mayor Ron Hoff and Alderman Joe Cronin for their outstanding service and dedication to the city during their terms.

Old Town Sewer Project: The City is working towards the development of sewers for the Old Town district of St. Paul. We are working with the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) on the required Stream Quality Studies. Upon DNR's completion and final report of this study, the City will proceed with initial engineering and design work for the sewer project. This design work will encompass the planned Phase 1, Old Town area. The Old Town Sewer Project is the highest priority project at hand before the City Board.

Community Clean Up Day: Saturday August 25th, 9:00am – Noon. The City will hold its “First Community Clean Up Day”. Your help is needed!
